OFFICE MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: REVISION OF BASIC PAY SCALES & ALLOWANCES OF CIVIL SERVANTS OF SINDH GOVERNMENT (2022).

The Government of Sindh has been pleased to sanction the revision of Basic Pay Scales & Allowances with effect from 1st July, 2022 for civil employees of the Sindh Government, paid out of civil estimates as mentioned in detail in following paragraphs:

PART-I (PAY)

02. **REVISION OF BASIC PAY SCALES:-**

The Basic Pay Scales-2022 shall replace the Basic Pay Scales-2017 with effect from 01.07.2022 as contained in **Annexure-I** of this Office Memorandum.

03. **FIXATION OF PAY OF THE EXISTING EMPLOYEES:-**

- i. The Basic Pay of an employee in service on 30.06.2022 shall be fixed in the Basic Pay Scales-2022 on point to point basis i.e. at the stage corresponding to that occupied by him/her above the minimum of Basic Pay Scales-2017;

In case of Personal Pay being drawn by an employee as part of his/her Basic Pay beyond the maximum of his/her pay scale on 30.06.2022, he/she shall continue to draw such pay in the Basic Pay Scales-2022 at the revised rates.

04. **FIXATION OF PAY ON PROMOTION:-**

In cases of promotion from a lower to higher posts/scale before introduction of these scales, the pay of the employees concerned in the revised pay scale may be fixed and so enhanced that it would not be less than the pay that would have been admissible to him if his promotion to higher post/scale had taken place after the introduction of these scales.

05. **ANNUAL INCREMENT:-**

Annual Increment shall continue to be admissible, subject to the existing conditions, on 1st December each year.

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PART-II (ALLOWANCES)

06. Upon introduction of Basic Pay Scale-2022, the following Ad-hoc Allowances shall cease to exist with effect from 01.07.2022:-

(i) Ad-hoc Allowance-2013:-

The Ad-hoc Relief Allowance-2013 as admissible under Para 6(i) of this Department's Office Memorandum No.FD(SR-I)(32)2011-2015, dated 22.07.2016 shall cease to exist with effect from 01.07.2022.

(ii) Ad-hoc Allowance-2015:-

The Ad-hoc Relief Allowance-2015 as admissible under Para 6(iii) of this Department's Office Memorandum No.FD(SR-I)(32)2011-2015, dated 22.07.2016 shall cease to exist with effect from 01.07.2022.

(iii) Ad-hoc Allowance-2016:-

The Ad-hoc Allowance-2016 @ 10% of the Basic Pay Scale-2016 granted w.e.f. 01.07.2016 vide Office Memorandum No.FD(SR-I)1(32)2011-2015 shall cease to exist with effect from 01.07.2022.

(iv) Ad-hoc Allowance-2017:-

The Ad-hoc Allowance-2017 @ 15% of the Basic Pay Scale-2017 granted w.e.f. 01.07.2017 vide Office Memorandum No.FD(SR-I)1(32)2011-2016 shall cease to exist with effect from 01.07.2022.

(v) Ad-hoc Allowance-2018:-

The Ad-hoc Allowance-2018 @ 10% of the Basic Pay Scale-2017 granted w.e.f. 01.07.2018 vide Office Memorandum No.FD(SR-I)1(32)2011-2016 shall cease to exist with effect from 01.07.2022.

(vi) Ad-hoc Allowance-2019:-

The Ad-hoc Allowance-2019 @ 15% of the Basic Pay Scale-2017 granted w.e.f. 01.07.2019 vide Office Memorandum No.FD(SR-I)1(32)2019-2020 shall cease to exist with effect from 01.07.2022.

(vii) Ad-hoc Allowance-2020:-

The Ad-hoc Allowance-2020 @ 05% of the Basic Pay Scale-2017 (BPS-17 & Above) and @ 10% of the Basic Pay Scale-2017 (BPS-1 to 16) granted w.e.f. 01.07.2020 vide Office Memorandum No.FD(SR-I)1(32)2020-2021 shall cease to exist with effect from 01.07.2022.

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- b) The Differential Allowance will be subject to Income Tax.
- c) The Differential Allowance will be admissible during leave and entire period of L.P.R except during Extra Ordinary Leave.
- d) The Differential Allowance will not be treated as part of emoluments for the purpose of calculation of Pension/Gratuity and recovery of House Rent.
- e) The Differential Allowance will not be admissible to the employees during tenure of their posting/deputation abroad.
- f) The Differential Allowance will be admissible to the employees on their repatriation from posting/deputation abroad at the rate and amount which would have been admissible to them, had they not been posted abroad.

09. SPECIAL PAY AND ALLOWANCES:-

All the Special Pays, Special Allowances or the Allowances admissible as percentage of pay (excluding those which are capped by fixing maximum limit) including House Rent Allowance and the Allowance / Special Allowance equal to one month basic pay, granted to Sindh Government employees irrespective of his/her posting in Department / Attached Department etc. including civil employees in BPS-1 to 22 of Judiciary shall stand frozen at the level of its admissibility as on 30.06.2022.

10. OPTION:-

- a. The Department / Attached Department to which an employee belongs and / or on whose pay roll he/she is borne shall obtain an option in written from such employees within 30 days commencing from the date of issue of this Office Memorandum and from the date of issue of this Office Memorandum and communicate it to the concerned Accounts Office/DDO, as the case may be, either to continue to draw salary in the Scheme of Basic Pay Scales-2017 or in this Office Memorandum. Option once exercised shall be considered final;
- b. An existing employee, as aforesaid, who does not exercise and communicate his/her option within the specified time limit, shall be deemed to have opted for the Scheme of Basic Pay Scales-2022.

11. All the existing rules / orders on the subject shall be considered to have been modified to the extent indicated above. All the existing rules / orders, not so modified, shall continue to be in force under this scheme.

12. ANOMALIES:-

An Anomaly Committee shall be set up in the Finance Department (Regulation Wing) to resolve the anomalies, if any, arising out in the implementation of the Basic Pay Scales-2022.

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(viii) Ad-hoc Allowance-2021:-

The Ad-hoc Allowance-2021 @ 20% of the Basic Pay Scale-2017 granted w.e.f. 01.07.2021 vide Office Memorandum No.FD(SR-I)1(32)2021-2022 shall cease to exist with effect from 01.07.2022.

AD-HOC RELIEF ALLOWANCE-2022:-

- a) An Ad-hoc Relief Allowance-2022 @ 15% of running basic pay of Basic Pay Scale-2017 shall be allowed to the civil employees of Sindh Government including contingent paid staff and contract employees employed against civil posts in Basic Pay Scales on standard terms and conditions of contract appointment with effect from 01.07.2022 and shall stand frozen at the same level till further orders.
- b) All the new entrants shall be allowed Ad-hoc Relief Allowance-2022 @ 15% of the minimum of the relevant of Basic Pay Scale-2017 on notional basis with effect from 01.07.2022 and shall stand frozen at the same level till further orders.
- c) The Ad-hoc Relief Allowance will be subject to Income Tax.
- d) The Ad-hoc Relief Allowance will be admissible during leave and entire period of L.P.R. except during Extra Ordinary Leave
- e) The Ad-hoc Relief Allowance will not be treated as part of emoluments for the purpose of calculation of Pension/Gratuity and recovery of House Rent.
- f) The Ad-hoc Relief Allowance will not be admissible to the employees during tenure of their posting/deputation abroad.
- g) The Ad-hoc Relief Allowance will be admissible to the employees on their repatriation from posting/deputation abroad at the rate and amount which would have been admissible to them, had they not been posted abroad.
- h) The Ad-hoc Relief Allowance will be admissible during the period of suspension;
- i) The term "Basic Pay" will also include the amount of Personal Pay granted on account of annual increment(s) beyond maximum of the existing pay scales.

DIFFERENTIAL ALLOWANCE: -

- a) A Differential Allowance @ 34.35% of basic pay of Basic Pay Scale-2017 to employees in BPS-1 to BPS-15 and @ 31.7% of basic pay of Basic Pay Scale-2017 to employees in BPS-16 to 22, shall be allowed, in lieu of the differential rate of Ad-hoc Relief Allowances-2013, 2015, 2017, 2019, 2020 and 2021 to the civil employees of Sindh Government including contingent paid staff and contract employees employed against civil posts in Basic Pay Scales on standard terms and conditions of contract appointment with effect from 01.07.2022 and shall stand frozen at the same level till further orders.
